Pietro delle Chiaie received a diploma in pianoforte, organ and composing for the organ with full marks from the Santa Cecilia Music Academy 's M Luigi Cheleghin. He took part in a course to become a substitute teacher run by the 'GRAN TEATRO LA FENICE DI VENEZIA'. He subsequently improved

under the guidance of professors such as O. LATRY, A. BONDEMANN, L. G. URIOL and H. HASELBOCK. He has played several concerts in Germany, Austria, France, Spain, Switzerland and the UK where he was unanimously acclaimed by the public and the critics thanks to his artistic and technical abilities. He has also studied the harpsichord at the S.A.P.M in Saluzzo with J. B. Christensen, with whom he also studied at the *Schola Cantorum Basiliensis*. He has been the regular cembalist and organist with the Cappella Musicale Enrico Stuart ensemble since 1998 where he regularly plays in duo with Rome Ciuffa, who plays the recorder. Together they have played in Italy, Spain, UK, Germany and Hungary and recorded various CD's. Since 1991 he has been the permanent organist and Kapellmeister at the Basilica Cattedrale of San Pietro Apostolo in Frascati (Rome).
